The museum was chartered in 1954 and began with one steam locomotive donated from the Louisville and Nashville Railroad. It opened to the public in 1958 on River Road in Louisville, but eventually outgrew its space and moved to a site on Lagrange Road, where it remained for many years. When the lease wasn't renewed, the museum opened its permanent facility in New Haven in summer 1990.
